Filip Roodhooft earned a Ph.D. in economics at the University of Antwerp in 1994. He is now professor of accounting on the faculty of economics and applied economics at the Katholieke Universiteit Leuven. He is the research dean of the Vlerick Leuven Ghent Management School. Roodhooft is on the board of directors of Realdolmen and chairs the audit committee.

Roodhooft has been a trainer and adviser for many organizations, including Accenture, Siemens, Delhaize, ING, BNP, Umicore, Alcatel, Bekaert, Suez, Belgacom, and the Belgian federal government. He has taught in executive development programs at several business schools, including the Vlerick Leuven Ghent Management School, the London Business School, the Rochester-Bern Executive MBA program, Universiteit Maastricht School of Business, the University of Antwerp Management School, and Leti-Lovanium Sint Petersburg. He has received several teaching awards.

His research interests include the application of case study research and experimental research in cost and management accounting and the use of financial accounting databases in business economics. His research has been published in several journals, among them the *Journal of Accounting Research*, *Accounting, Organizations and Society*; the *Journal of Management Accounting Research*; *Accounting and Business Research*; the *Journal of Business Finance and Accounting*, and the *Harvard Business Review*.
